## Financial Report

The post had a decent month in June. With a major expenditure for a new air conditioning unit for \$2164.00 we still made a profit of \$1,684.55, or 4.2% with Charitable Contribution of \$1630.00 or 4.0%.

All categories, income and expenses seem to be in line with previous months for revenue by percentage and expenses by percentage with the exception of Maintenance. July should be a little better because of the Annual Charity Golf Outing, and additional Revenue from the event.

Discussion of a new ATM was held for the post. It was approved and will be installed in August 2010. This is not intended to stop check cashing but rather enhance the capability of current members in the Armed Forces who get paid on their Military Debit Cards to be able to enjoy the Post and it's offerings. They now have the capability of getting cash to spend at the post. It is a paper debit card machine, that you will get 2 receipts, take a copy of the receipt to the bartender for cash. There will be a charge of \$2.50 for each transaction. The post will only make .25 cents and the rest is fee to the servicer. It will be on a lease of 4 years, with a 90 trial, with no obligation. If it is deemed to be non-effective, we can cancel the lease at no expense to the Post.

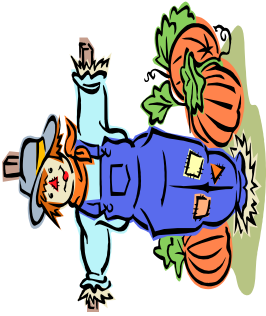
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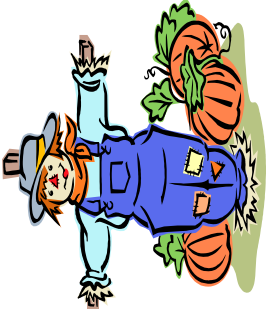
